If you recieve the following popup error upon starting Outlook, then you have a corrupt registry key that can easily be corrected.

8	Error in registry for extension "Exchange Extensions;?". The syntax or format of the registry entry is incorrect. Check the registry settings and compare the registry for this extension to other extensions in the registry.

The short version is:

- 1. Close Outlook
- 2. Open the Registry Editor
- 3. Drill down to this registry key:

 $HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE \ Software \ Microsoft \ Exchange \ Client \ Extensions$

- 4. Delete the value named "Exchange Extensions"
- 5. Launch Outlook again. Outlook will recreate the key.
